Paddler's Notes

- 82.0 Mile 9 Mile Creek Landing** **River:** Shallow riffles and scattered boulders are common all the way to Barnaby Rapids. Try to stick to the main channel as the river is shallow in many places. **Shuttle:** On highway 70, the landing is west of the Nine Mile Creek Bridge, on the north side of the road. Trailer ramp access, parking, pit toilets, water.
- 80.2 Mile Le Tourneau Creek** The creek enters from river left.
- 79.3 Mile Barnaby Rapids (Class 1)** The first of two low hazard boulder gardens begins in a left bend. The second is several hundred yards downstream.
- 78.0 Mile Butternut Creek** The creek enters from river right. The river widens after the creek and several islands are downstream.
- 76.9 Mile Deadmans Slough Landing** **River:** Shortly after a pair of islands, you will approach another, larger island. Paddle down the left fork to access the gravel landing. Downstream, The river runs along Highway 70 for the next mile. **Shuttle:** On Highway 70, the landing is 0.3 miles west of the North Fork Road intersection. Trailer access ramp, parking, trailer turnaround.
- 75.5 Mile County Line Camp (Canoe Campsite #1)** The camp is on the left bank with two sites. The south site has better shade.
- 72.5 Mile Pine Creek, Oxbo Camp (Canoe Campsite #2)** The creek enters from river right after a sharp left bend. The campsite is on river left a short distance downstream and features three sites.
- 70.6 Mile Dix Dox Landing** **River:** Shortly after a narrow island, you will see a paved access ramp under a sign marked Dix Dox Landing. Two bridges are visible downstream, the first is a rusted steel ATV bridge and the second is the Highway 70 Bridge. **Shuttle:** From highway 70, turn north onto Harz Road and drive past Oxbo Resort. The entrance is marked with a 'boat landing' sign. This is an excellent developed landing with a large paved parking area, trailer access ramp, trailer turnaround, pit toilets, and water.
