Paddler's Notes

- **52.4 Mile** Camp 41 Landing River: There is 200 yards of flat-water before the first pitch of Wannigan Rapids. Shuttle: On West Lane Road, the landing entrance is marked with a sign. Probably the most used landing on the Flambeau River. Hand carry access, two parking areas, trailer turnaround, water, pit toilets.
- **52.3 Mile** Camp 41 Camp (Canoe Campsite # 9) Three sites sit on the left bank near the beginning of Wannigan Rapids.
- **52.0 Mile** Wannigan Rapids, 1st Pitch (Class 1-2) The rapids begin a few hundred yards downstream from Camp 41 Landing. The difficulty of the rapids depends on water levels. At low water this can be a scrappy ride, at high water, fun waves develop.
- **50.7 Mile** Wannigan Camp (Canoe Campsite # 10) The camp is on river right just before the second pitch of Wannigan Rapids. There are two shaded sites.
- **50.6 Mile** Wannigan Rapids, 2nd Pitch (Class 1-2) The river rushes through 500 yards of wavy rapids and boulders beneath a steep, wooded right bank. This second pitch is a little more difficult than the first.
- **49.9 Mile** Wannigan Rapids, 3rd Pitch (Class 2) The river narrows and bends to the right through the third pitch of Wannigan Rapids. A high-speed wavy class 2 with a narrow rocky island running down center-left near the end of the rapids. A wide green lawn and a few cottages are on the right bank.
- **49.4 Mile** Flambeau Falls Rapids (Class 2) The rapids occur in a right bend, just below Dodes Island. Scout from the trail on the left (east) bank.
- **48.6 Mile South Fork Confluence, Forks Camp (Canoe Campsite # 11)**The South Fork of the Flambeau River enters from river left. Forks camp is located on the left bank just below the confluence. The camp has two sites. The river widens considerably with the added flow and wind can sometimes be a factor, especially from the south or west.
- **47.0 Mile** Bear Run Camp (Canoe Campsite # 12) The camp is on the left bank shortly after a right bend. There are three sites with plenty of shade.
- **46.4 Mile**Hervas Camp Landing (Canoe Campsite # 13) River: A little more than a half-mile past Bear Run Camp you will see Hervas Camp Landing on the left bank. The landing and camp are a few yards past a patch of tall marsh grass surrounding the mouth of a small stream. Hervas Camp features three shaded sites. The spring fed stream is George Ladd Creek. Shuttle: From County B, turn north onto River Road and continue for several miles to the end. Trailer access ramp, parking, pit toilets, water.
- **45.5 Mile** Cedar Rapids Camp (Canoe Campsite # 14) The camp is on the right bank, downstream from a cottage. There are three sites.
- **45.4 Mile**Cedar Rapids, 1st Pitch (Class 2+)

 A challenging rapids that occurs where the river forks around a small, rocky, wooded island. The right fork is usually too shallow for canoes. The navigable left fork features a short, steep gradient with a series of wavy drops, and a number of boulders, followed by another 50 yards of fun, challenging rapids. Scouting is necessary as the intial pitch contains several submerged boulders that you will not be able to see from upstream. Land on the left bank above the rapids and scout from the well-worn trail. Portage on river left if you have any doubts.

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- **44.5 Mile** Cedar Rapids, 2nd Pitch (Class 1-2) Not as difficult as the first pitch, this long and shallow boulder garden begins where the river constricts after a right bend.
- **43.5 Mile** Cedar Rapids, 3rd Pitch (Class 1-2) The river flows through a shallow boulder garden in a left bend, and then plunges over a submerged ledge that extends out from the left bank.
- **42.5 Mile** Cedar Rapids, 4th Pitch (Class 1-2) A series of riffles and easy boulder gardens precede the 4th pitch of Cedar Rapids, where the river constricts into another scrappy boulder garden.
- **42.0 Mile**Beaver Dam Rapids (Class 2-3) The rapids begin with a 4-foot drop. In medium flows, the current will push you into a "sleeper" a large submerged boulder down the left-center of the drop. If you are not careful with your line you may literally be launched off this boulder. Scout or Portage on the left (east) bank. Novice paddlers should portage to just below the drop. A shallow boulder field follows.
- **41.5 Mile**Beaver Dam Landing River: The landing is a large stone ledge on the right bank within view of Beaver Dam Rapids.
 Shuttle: From Highway 8, turn north onto County Highway I, then turn east onto Flambeau Road and continue on until you see the river access sign. Hand carry access, parking, trailer turnaround, pit toilets.

EXTRA MILES

- **40.6 Mile** Little Cedar Rapids (Class 1) A stretch of rocky riffles in a wide right bend lead into Little Cedar Rapids, an easy class 1 with a small rock shelf on river right.
- **36.7 Mile**Flambeau Lodge, Landing River: The river slows and widens considerably as it flows into the Big Falls Flowage, formed by the Big Falls Dam. The landing is on the right bank downstream of a small bay on river left. **Shuttle:** From Highway 8, turn north onto County Highway I, then turn east onto Flambeau Road. The Lodge is a privately owned resort that offers camping, parking for canoeists and kayakers (fee), shuttle services and rentals.
