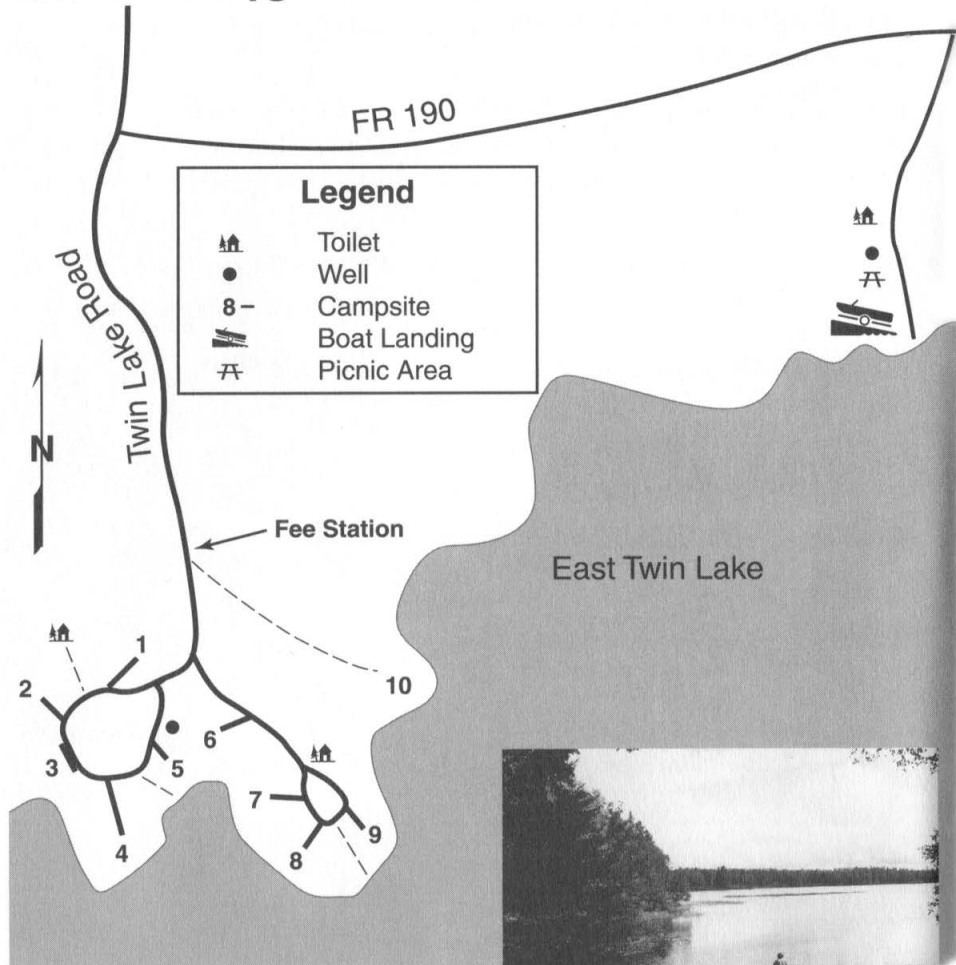


East Twin Campground



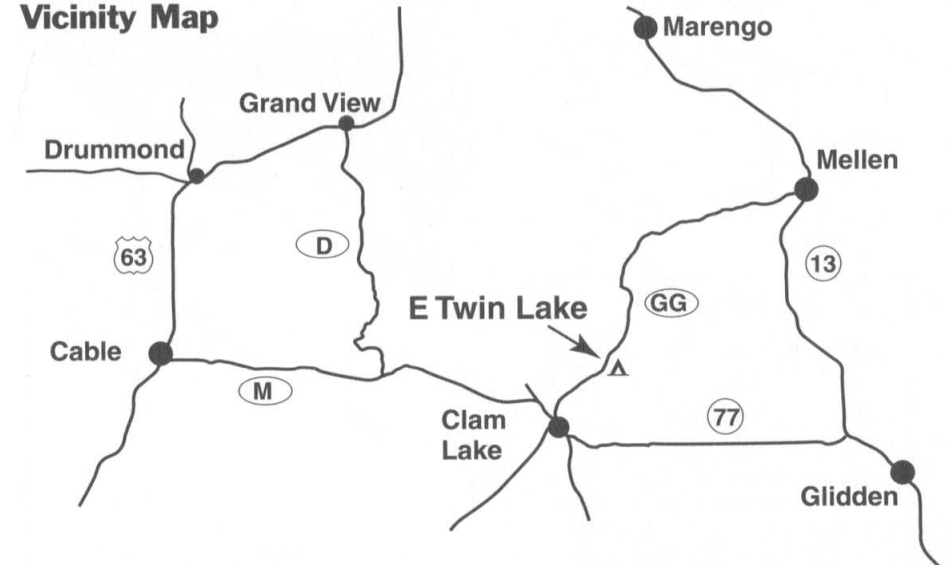
Attractions

- The campground is located in a maple, birch and hemlock forest on 110-acre East Twin Lake
- East Twin Lake has musky, largemouth bass, and panfish
- A spur trail and township roads open to ATV's link East Twin CG to the Dead Horse Run ATV Trail
- A boat landing is located 0.5 mile east of the campground
- Close to store, gas and churches

Directions to East Twin Lake Campground

- From Mellen drive southwest on County Highway GG 14.8 miles. Turn left (south) at the campground sign and drive 0.5 mile to the campground.
- From Cable drive east on County Highway M 19.5 miles to County Highway GG. Turn left (north) on GG and drive 3.4 miles to the campground sign. Turn right (south) and drive 0.5 mile to the campground.
- From Glidden drive north on Highway 13 three miles to Highway 77. Turn left (west) on 77 and drive 13.5 miles to Clam Lake. Turn right (northwest) on County Highways GG & M and in 0.1 mile turn right (north) on GG and proceed 3.4 miles to the campground sign. Turn right (south) and drive 0.5 mile to the campground.
