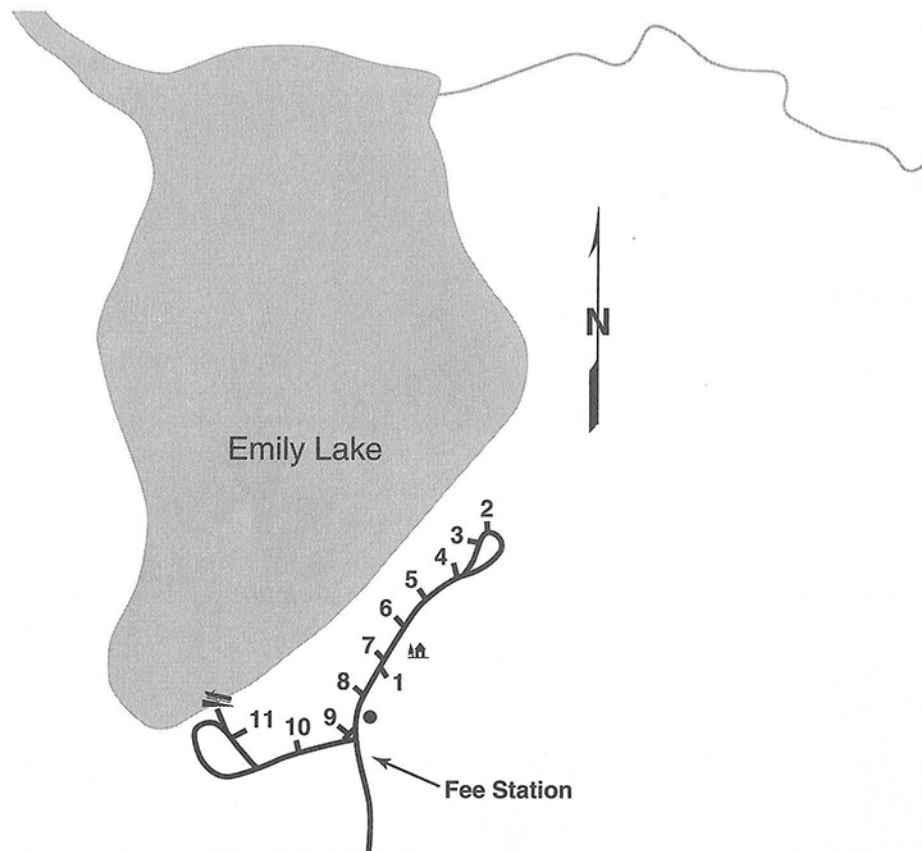


## Emily Lake Campground

### Attractions

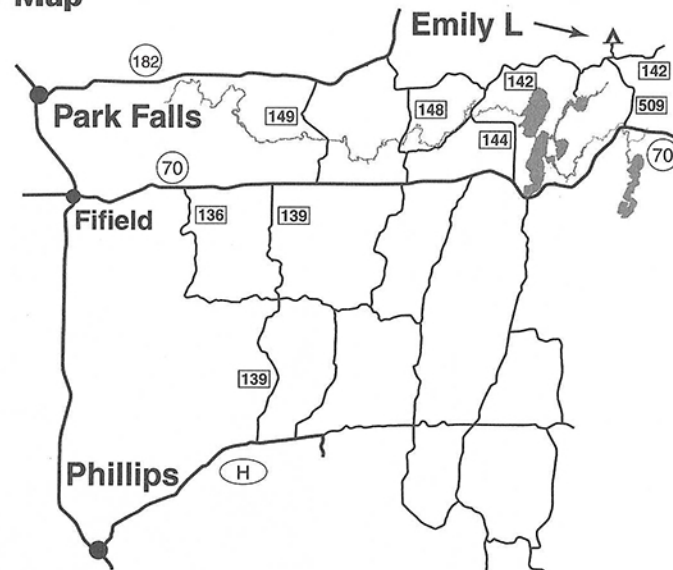
- 26 acre lake with northern pike, crappie, perch, and panfish

## Directions To Emily Lake Campground

- From the intersection of Highways 13 and 70 in Fifield drive east on Highway 70 22.3 miles to FR 509 (Chippewa Trail). Turn left (north) and continue on FR 509 3.1 miles to FR 142. Turn right (east) on FR 142 and drive 0.2 mile to FR 1178. Turn left (north) and continue 0.5 mile to the campground.
