- Fishing for walleye, northern pike, largemouth and smallmouth bass, perch, and panfish



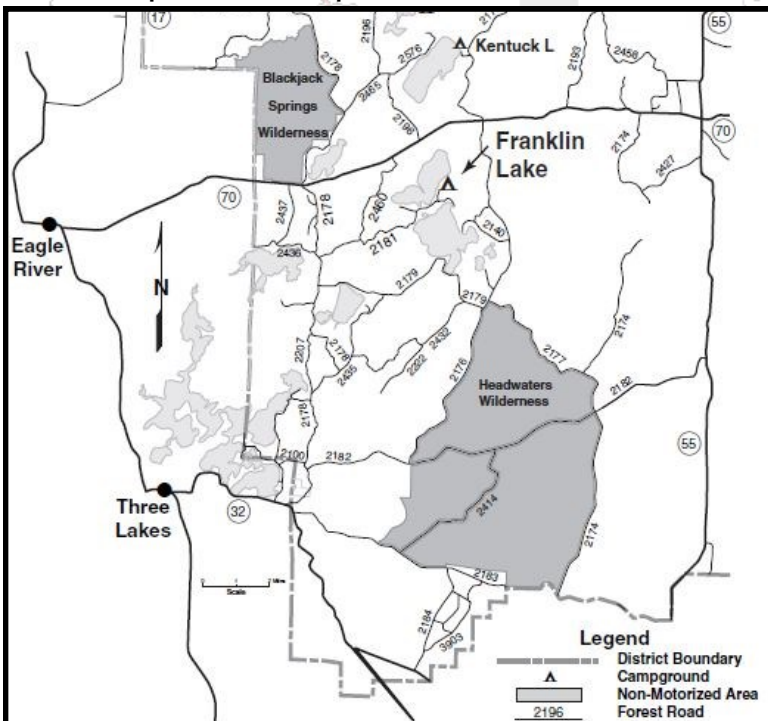
Location

From Eagle River travel east 7.6 miles on Highway 70 to FR 2178 (Military Road). Turn right (south) on FR 2178 and continue 2.8 miles to FR 2181. Turn left (east) and travel 4.6 miles to the campground.

Campsite Capacity

Individual campsite capacity may not exceed 3 vehicles and 8 people.

Vehicle capacity limit includes vehicles, wheeled camping units and trailers.

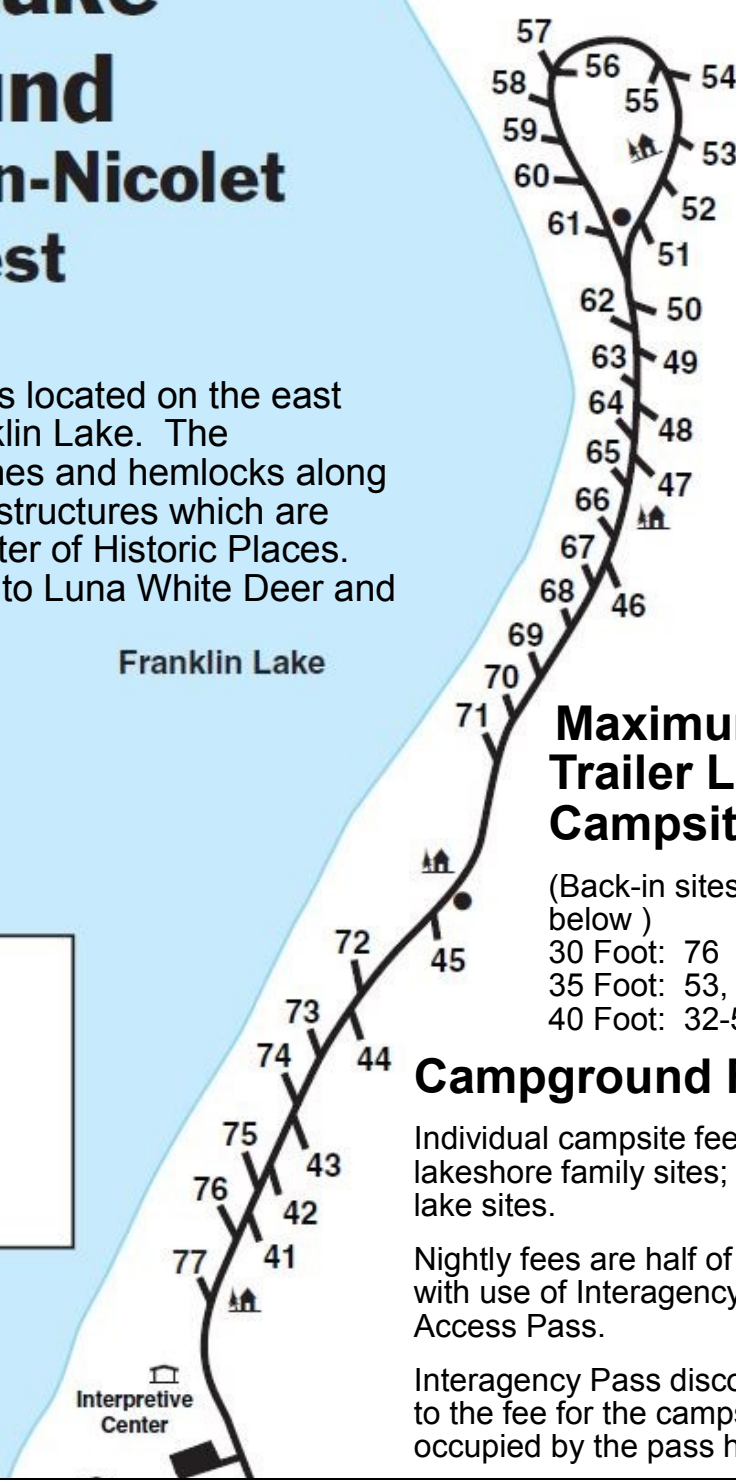


Description

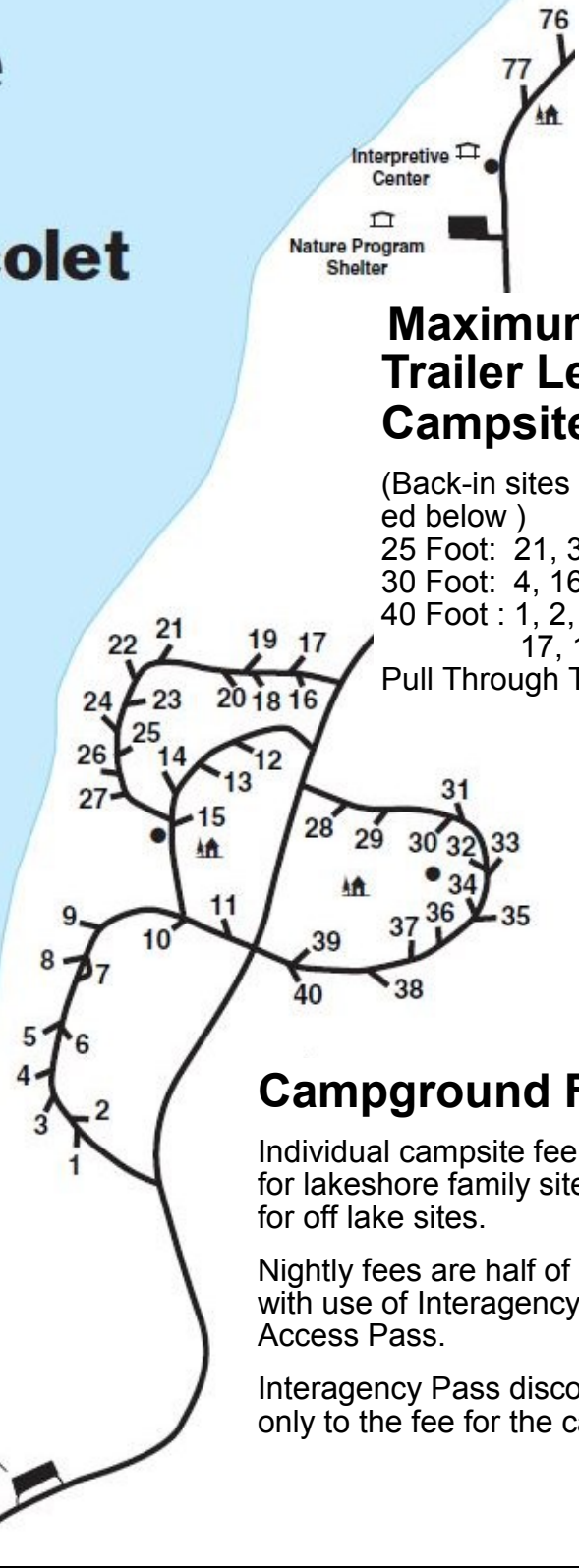
