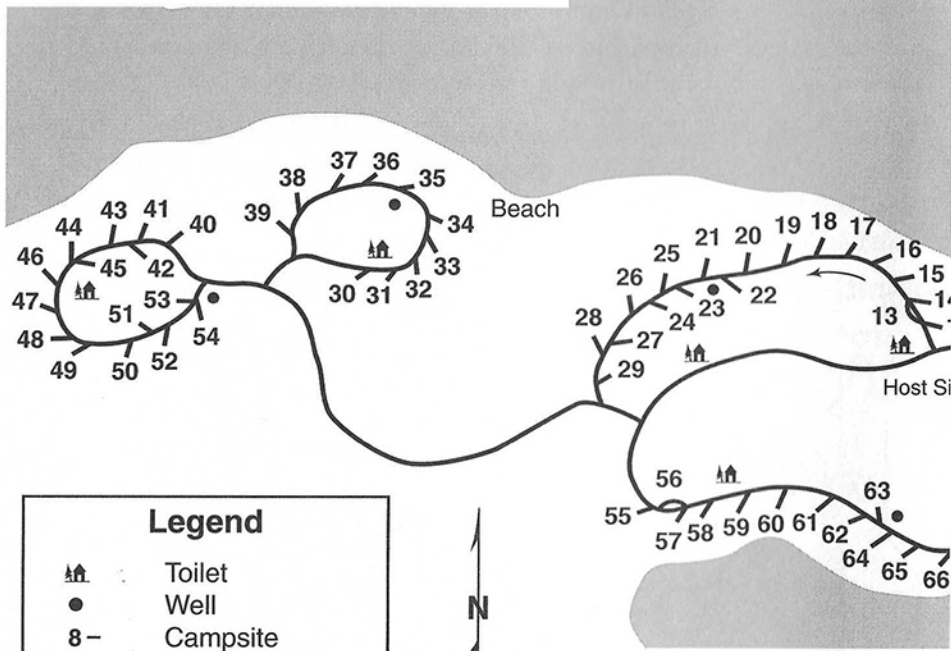


# Two Lakes Campground

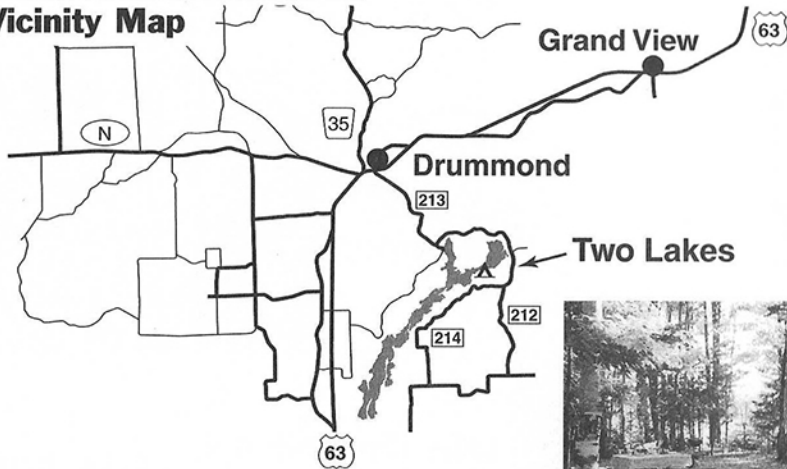


**Legend**

- Picnic Area



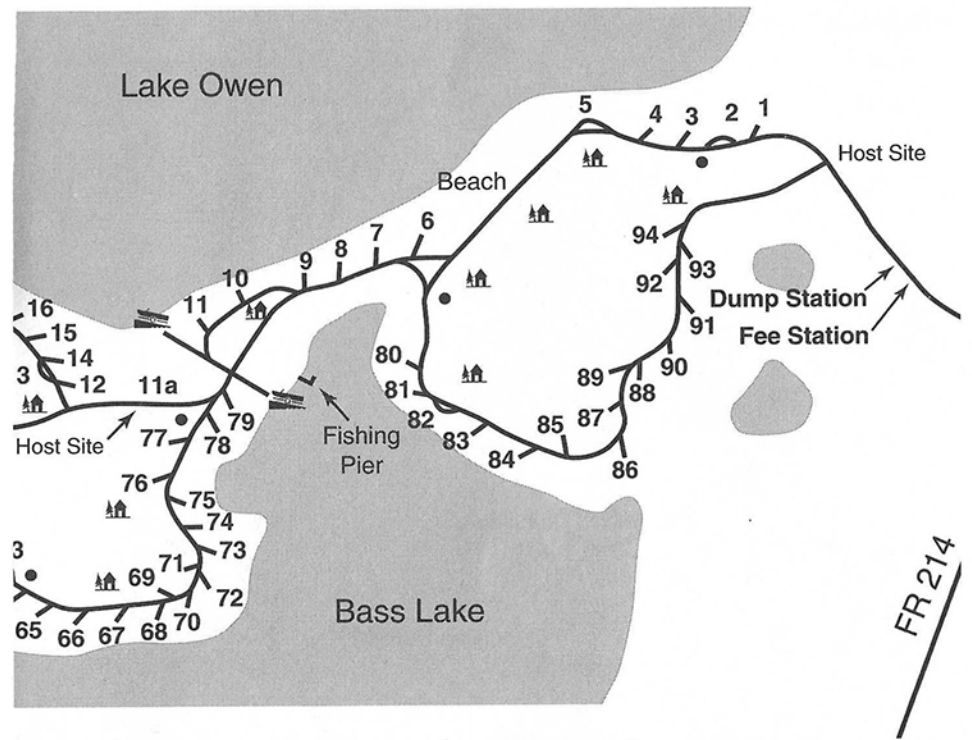
## Vicinity Map
