Carrol Lake Campground, sites 101-119, is located in the southern portion of the forest on Carrol Lake. This campground is well-used because of the generally good fishing for both panfish and game fish on this 352-acre lake. Additionally, there is an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessible fishing pier, boat landing and picnic area. There is a sandy beach inside the campground, along with an adjoining grassy area for lounging.

Camping reservations are required and can be made for the same day of your arrival or up to 11 months in advance of your planned date of occupancy.

Campers must make a reservation before setting up on any site.

TICKS AND LYME DISEASE

Ticks are common across Wisconsin and may be found in the forest. Lyme disease is an illness that can be spread to humans from the bite of a tick. You can protect yourself against Lyme disease and other tick-borne diseases by practicing these tips:

- Stay in the middle of trails.
- Apply insect repellent on exposed skin and over clothes.
- Wear light-colored clothes to spot ticks more easily.
- Do a full-body tick check after outdoors activities.

VEHICLE STICKER

A vehicle admission sticker is required on all motor vehicles within the campgrounds at Northern Highland-American Legion State Forest.



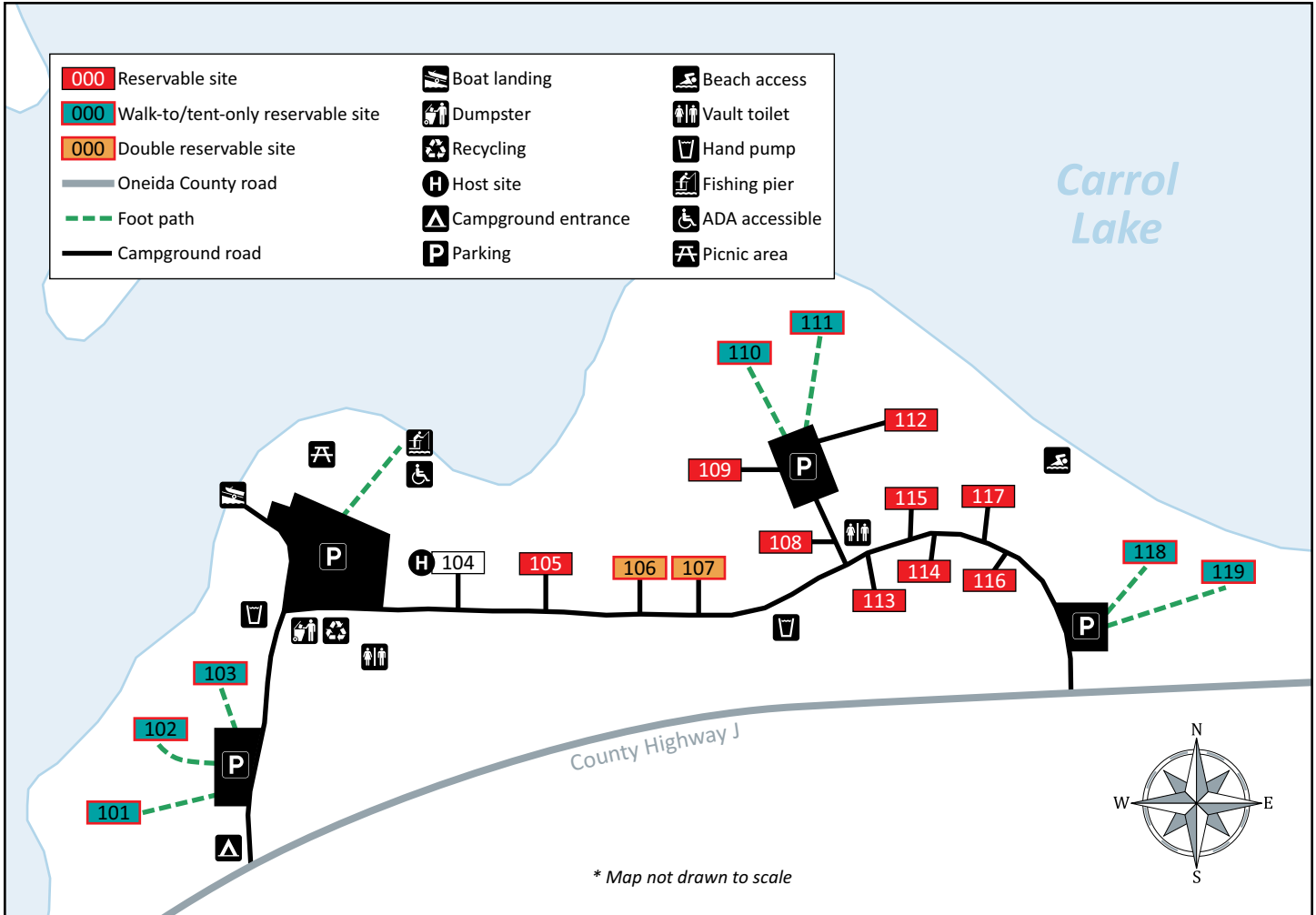

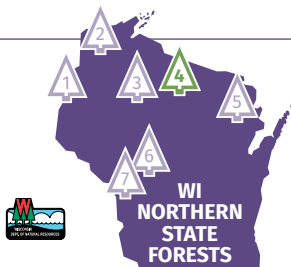


CAMPGROUND RULES

- **All campers must make a reservation before setting up on any site.**
- **Checkout Time:** Must vacate site by 3 p.m. on the last day of the permit.
- **Campground/Day-use Areas and Closing Time:** Campground closed to nonregistered campers 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- **Pets** must be on a leash at all times and not left unattended.
- **Generators** may be used from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- **Noise** may not interfere with the enjoyment of the forest by others.

Visit dnr.wi.gov for a complete list of camping rules. Violations may be reported to the Wisconsin DNR Tipline at 800-847-9367.

- **Camping Party:** A “non-family group” may not exceed six people. A “family” is limited to parents with their dependent children and not more than two guests.
- **A State Parks and Forest Admission Sticker** is required for camping.
- For complete rules and regulations, see Chapter NR 45, Wis. Admin. Code, or contact DNR Law Enforcement.
