WELCOME!

Cunard Lake Campground, sites 1101-1133, is located in the southern portion of the forest on Cunard Lake. This campground offers campers the quiet peacefulness they are looking for. Cunard Lake is a 43-acre electric-motors-only lake, offering opportunities for exploring canoers and kayakers, and adjoins to a creek that empties into Sweeney Lake. A boat landing and parking area is adjacent to the campground entrance. A lovely sandy beach with sturdy steps offer swimmers a relaxing location while camping. This is also one of our designated quiet campgrounds – no generators or loud electronic devices allowed. **Camping reservations are required and can be made for the same day of your arrival or up to 11 months in advance of your planned date of occupancy. Campers must make a reservation before setting up on any site.**

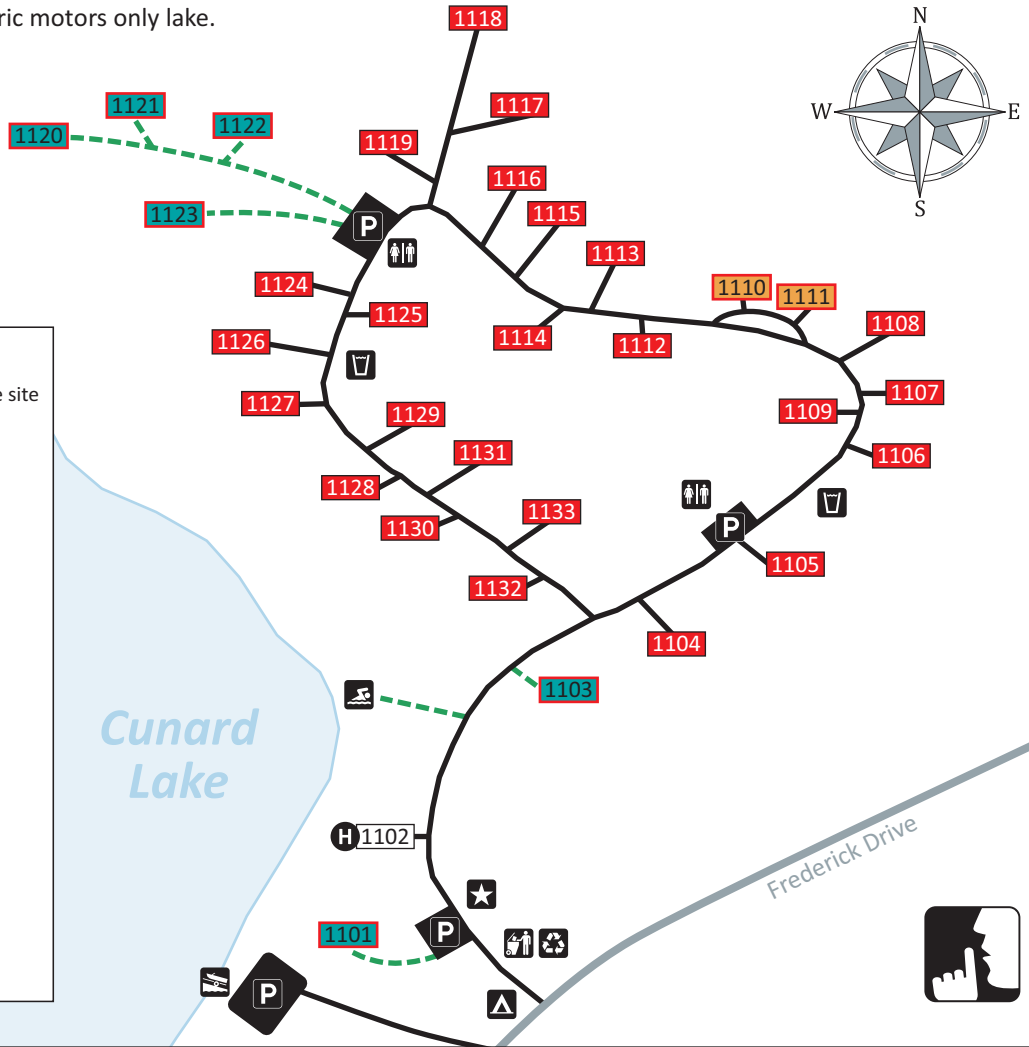
Cunard Lake Campground beach area.

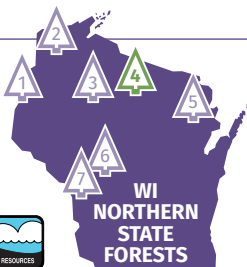

CAMPGROUND RULES

- Campers must make a reservation before setting up on any site.
- **Checkout Time:** Must vacate site by 3 p.m. on the last day of the permit.
- **Campground/Day-use Areas and Closing Time:** Campground closed to nonregistered campers 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- **Pets** must be on a leash at all times and not left unattended.
- **Noise** may not interfere with the enjoyment of the forest by others.
- **Camping Party:** A “non-family group” may not exceed six people. A “family” is limited to parents with their dependent children and not more than two guests.
- **A State Parks and Forest Admission Sticker** is required for camping.
- For complete rules and regulations, see Chapter NR 45, Wis. Admin. Code, or contact DNR Law Enforcement.
