WELCOME!

North Trout Lake Campground, sites 1401-1448, is in the northern portion of the Northern Highland American Legion State Forest along the eastern shoreline of the north basin of Trout Lake. The 3,816-acre lake provides crystal clear swimming waters, excellent fishing and boating recreation opportunities. A large area to access these pristine waters for picnicking, swimming and a boat landing and parking area are within walking distance of the campground. Also available is access to North Trout Lake Nature Trail. **All sites are reservable and campers must make a reservation before setting up.** Reservations can be made up to the day of arrival and no more than 11 months in advance.

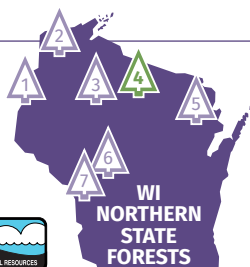
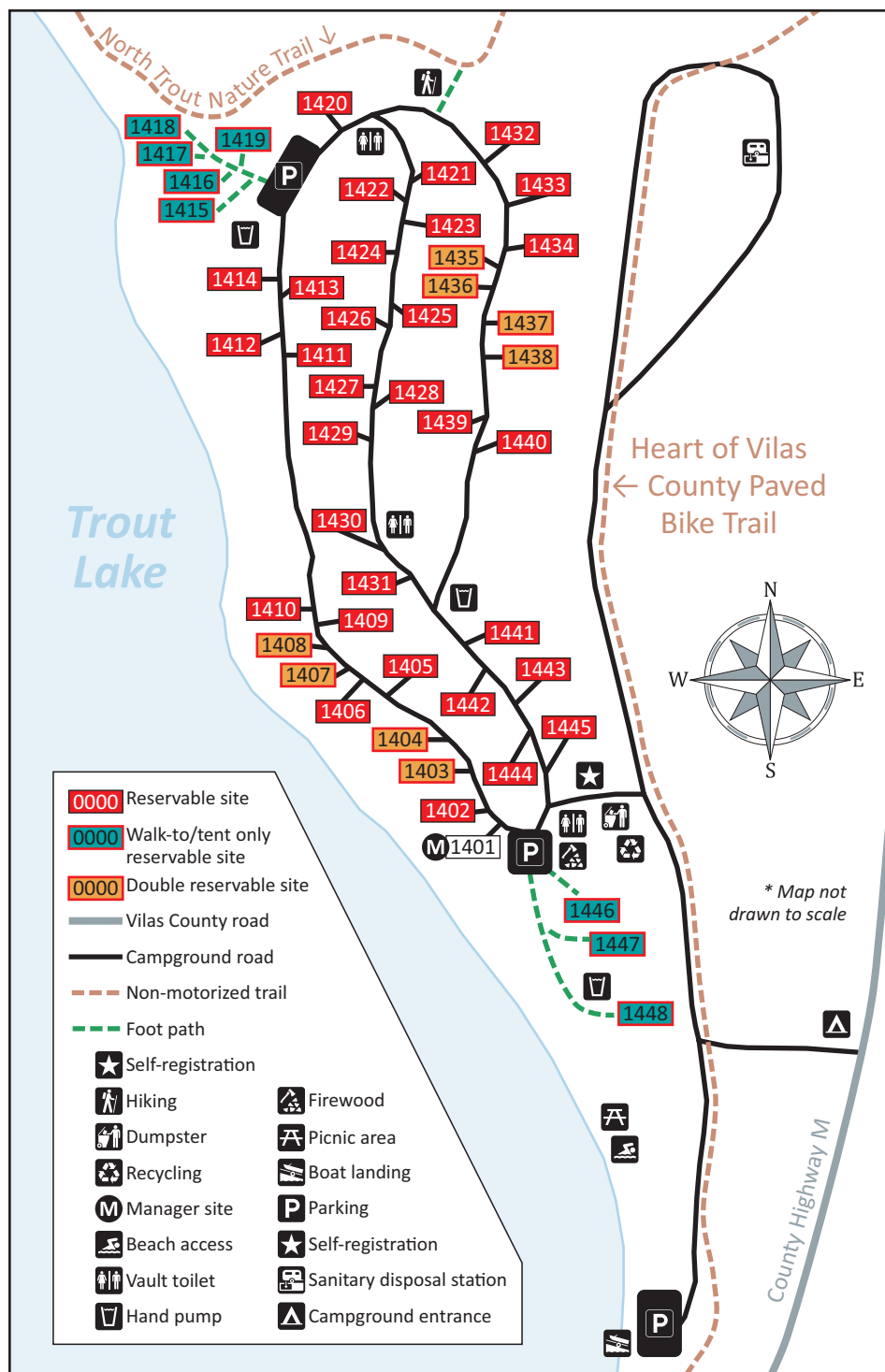
CAMPGROUND RULES

- All campers must make a reservation before setting up on any site.
- **Checkout Time:** Must vacate site by 3 p.m. on the last day of the permit.
- **Campground/Day-use Areas and Closing Time:** Campground closed to nonregistered campers 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- **Pets** must be on a leash at all times and not left unattended.
- **Noise** may not interfere with the enjoyment of the forest by others.
- **Generators** may be used from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- **Camping Party:** A “non-family group” may not exceed six people. A “family” is limited to parents with their dependent children and not more than two guests.
- **A State Parks and Forest Admission Sticker** is required for camping.
- For complete rules and regulations, see Chapter NR 45, Wis. Admin. Code, or contact DNR Law Enforcement.
