## WELCOME!

**Starrett Lake Campground**, sites 1301-1344, is in the middle portion of the Northern Highland American Legion State Forest on the southern end of Starrett Lake. This 66-acre lake allows electric motors only with slow-no-wake speed. Canoers and kayakers often enjoy spending time on this lake. There are fair fishing opportunities for bass, panfish, northern pike and even walleye. A turnaround boat landing offers access to Starrett Lake. This is one of our designated quiet campgrounds – no generator usage or loud electronic devices allowed. **All sites are reservable and campers must make a reservation before setting up.** Reservations can be made up to the day of arrival and no more than 11 months in advance.

## CAMPGROUND RULES

- All campers must make a reservation before setting up on any site.
- **Checkout Time:** Must vacate site by 3 p.m. on the last day of the permit.
- **Campground/Day-use Areas and Closing Time:** Campground closed to nonregistered campers 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- **Pets** must be on a leash at all times and not left unattended.
- **Noise** may not interfere with the enjoyment of the forest by others.
- **Camping Party:** A “non-family group” may not exceed six people. A “family” is limited to parents with their dependent children and not more than two guests.
- **A State Parks and Forest Admission Sticker** is required for camping.
- For complete rules and regulations, see Chapter NR 45, Wis. Admin. Code, or contact DNR Law Enforcement.

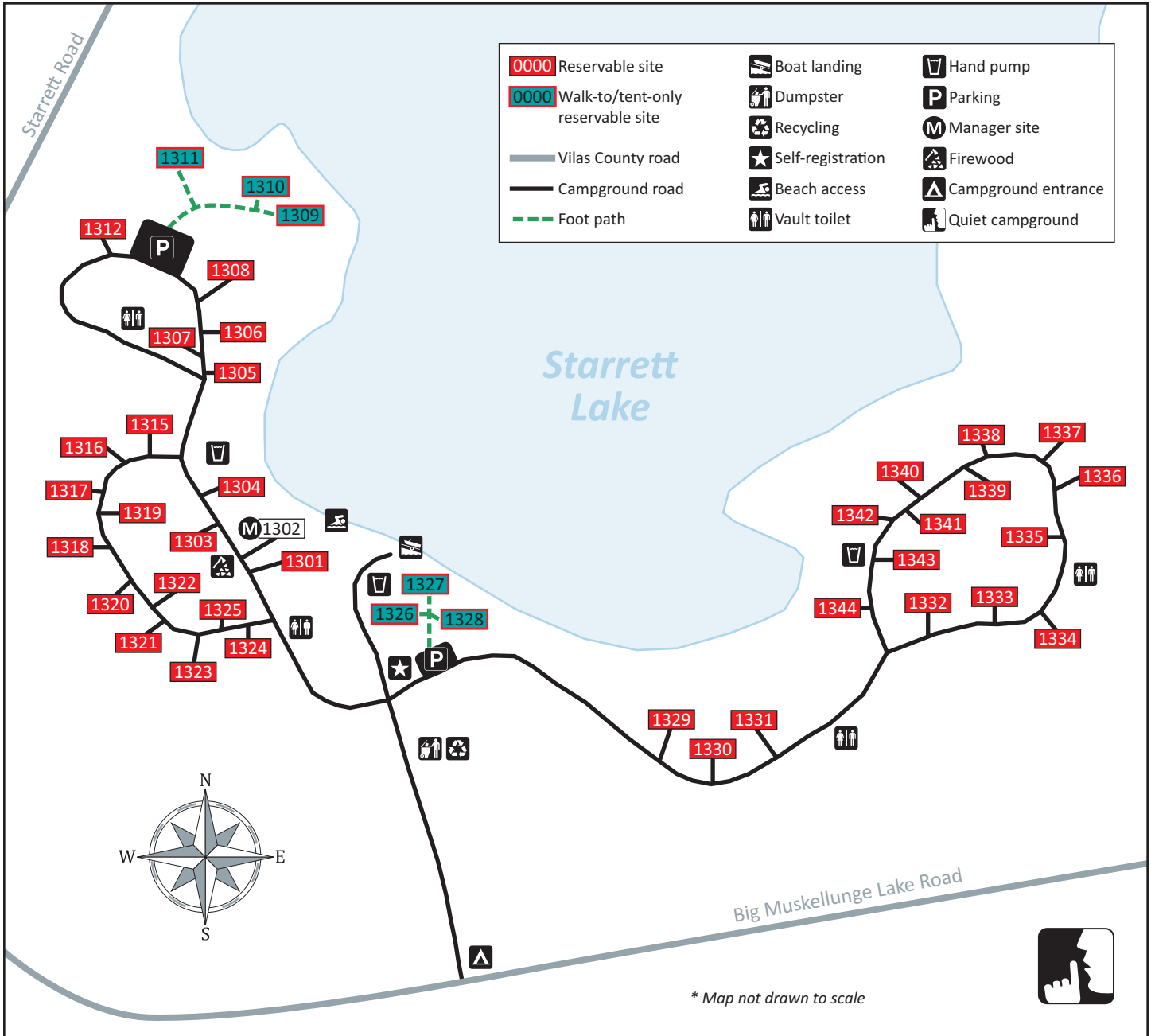

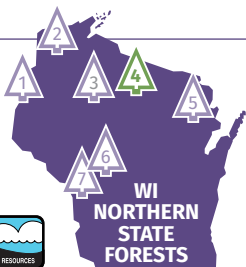
