WELCOME!

Upper Gresham Lake Campground, sites 1501-1525, is in the middle portion of the Northern Highland American Legion State Forest on the northeast corner of Upper Gresham Lake. This popular 362-acre lake is known for great fishing and boating. There is also an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) designated fishing pier located adjacent to the boat landing area as well as parking. Within the campground, you will find a small updated beach that gives campers swimming opportunities. **All sites are reservable and campers must make a reservation before setting up.** Reservations can be made up to the day of arrival and no more than 11 months in advance.

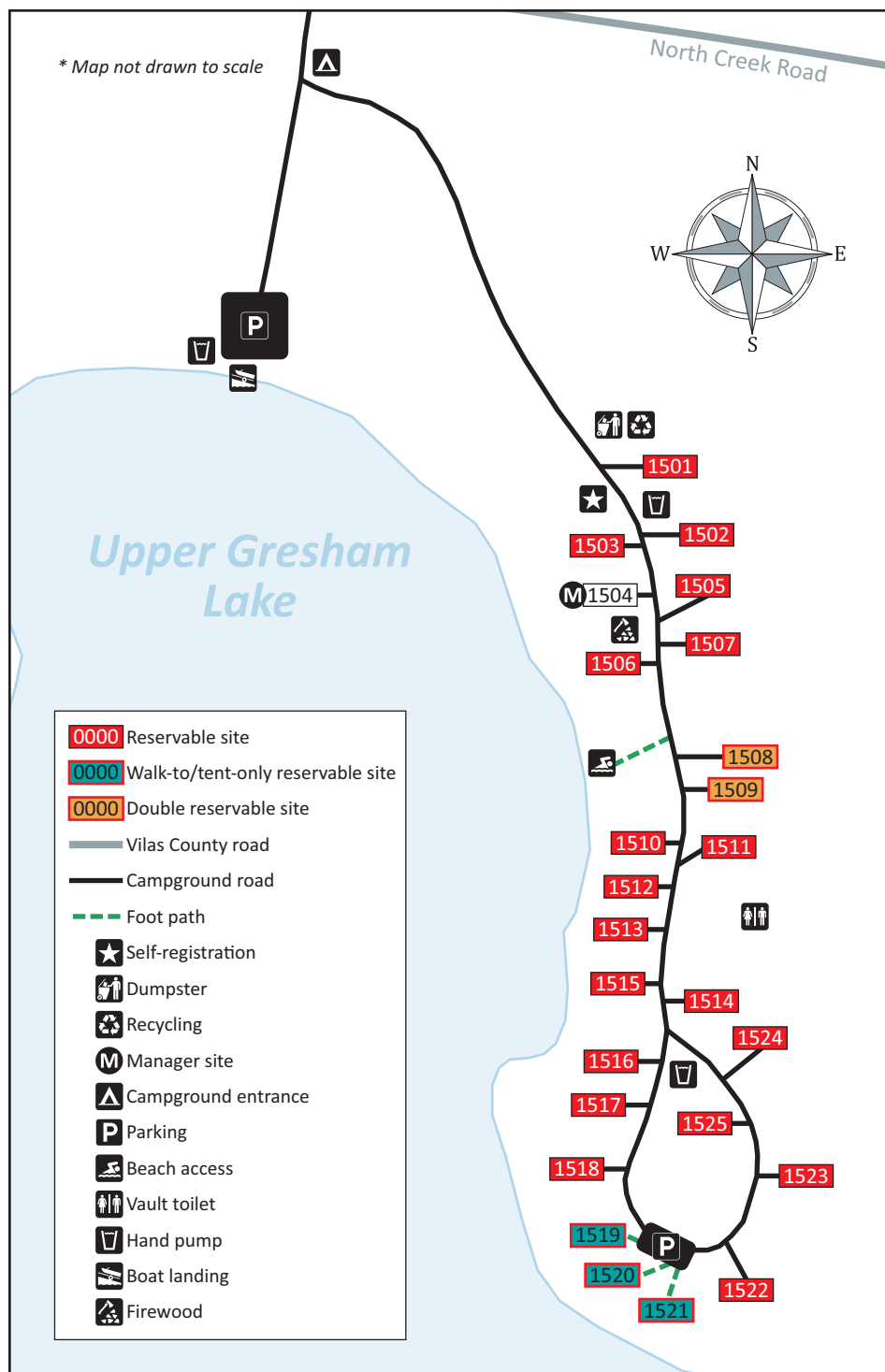

CAMPGROUND RULES

- All campers must make a reservation before setting up on any site.
- **Checkout Time:** Must vacate site by 3 p.m. on the last day of the permit.
- **Campground/Day-use Areas and Closing Time:** Campground closed to nonregistered campers 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- **Pets** must be on a leash at all times and not left unattended.
- **Noise** may not interfere with the enjoyment of the forest by others.
- **Generators** may be used from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- **Camping Party:** A “non-family group” may not exceed six people. A “family” is limited to parents with their dependent children and not more than two guests.
- **A State Parks and Forest Admission Sticker** is required for camping.
- For complete rules and regulations, see Chapter NR 45, Wis. Admin. Code, or contact DNR Law Enforcement.
