WELCOME!

East Star Lake Campground, sites 1601-1630, is located in the east central portion of the state forest on the southeast corner of Star Lake. The 1,206-acre lake is well-known for excellent fishing and clear waters for swimming. The marked swimming area offers scenic views of beautiful Star Lake. The boat landing is adjacent to the campground entrance with a vault toilet building, hand pump for water and a parking area. **All sites are reservable and campers must make a reservation before setting up.** Reservations can be made up to the day of arrival and no more than 11 months in advance.

East Star Lake is excellent for fishing and swimming in the crystal clear water.

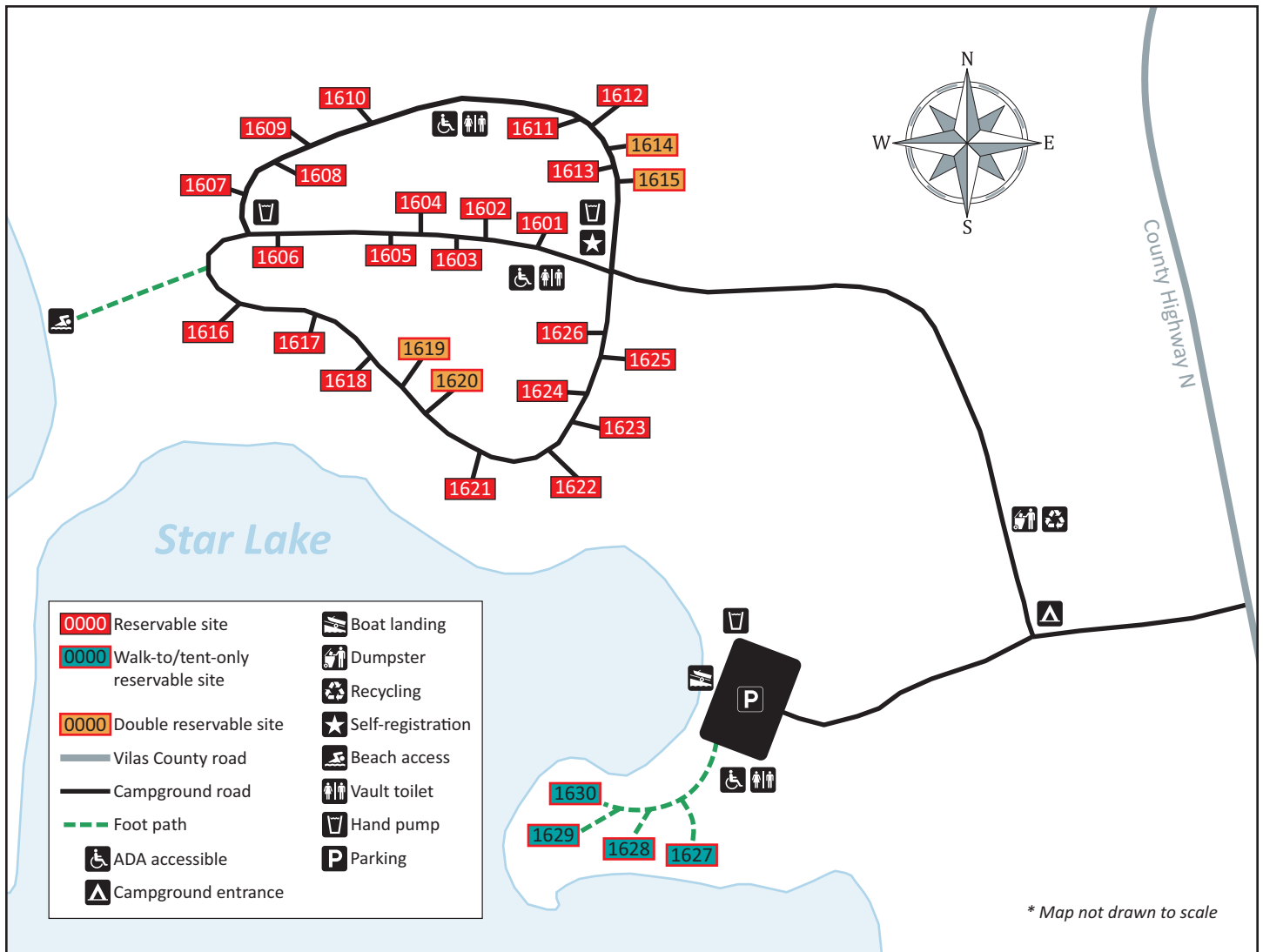

CAMPGROUND RULES

- All campers must make a reservation before setting up on any site.
- **Checkout Time:** Must vacate site by 3 p.m. on the last day of the permit.
- **Campground/Day-use Areas and Closing Time:** Campground closed to nonregistered campers 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- **Pets** must be on a leash at all times and not left unattended.
- **Generators** may be used from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- **Noise** may not interfere with the enjoyment of the forest by others.
- **Camping Party:** A “non-family group” may not exceed six people. A “family” is limited to parents with their dependent children and not more than two guests.
- **A State Parks and Forest Admission Sticker** is required for camping.
- For complete rules and regulations, see Chapter NR 45, Wis. Admin. Code, or contact DNR Law Enforcement.
