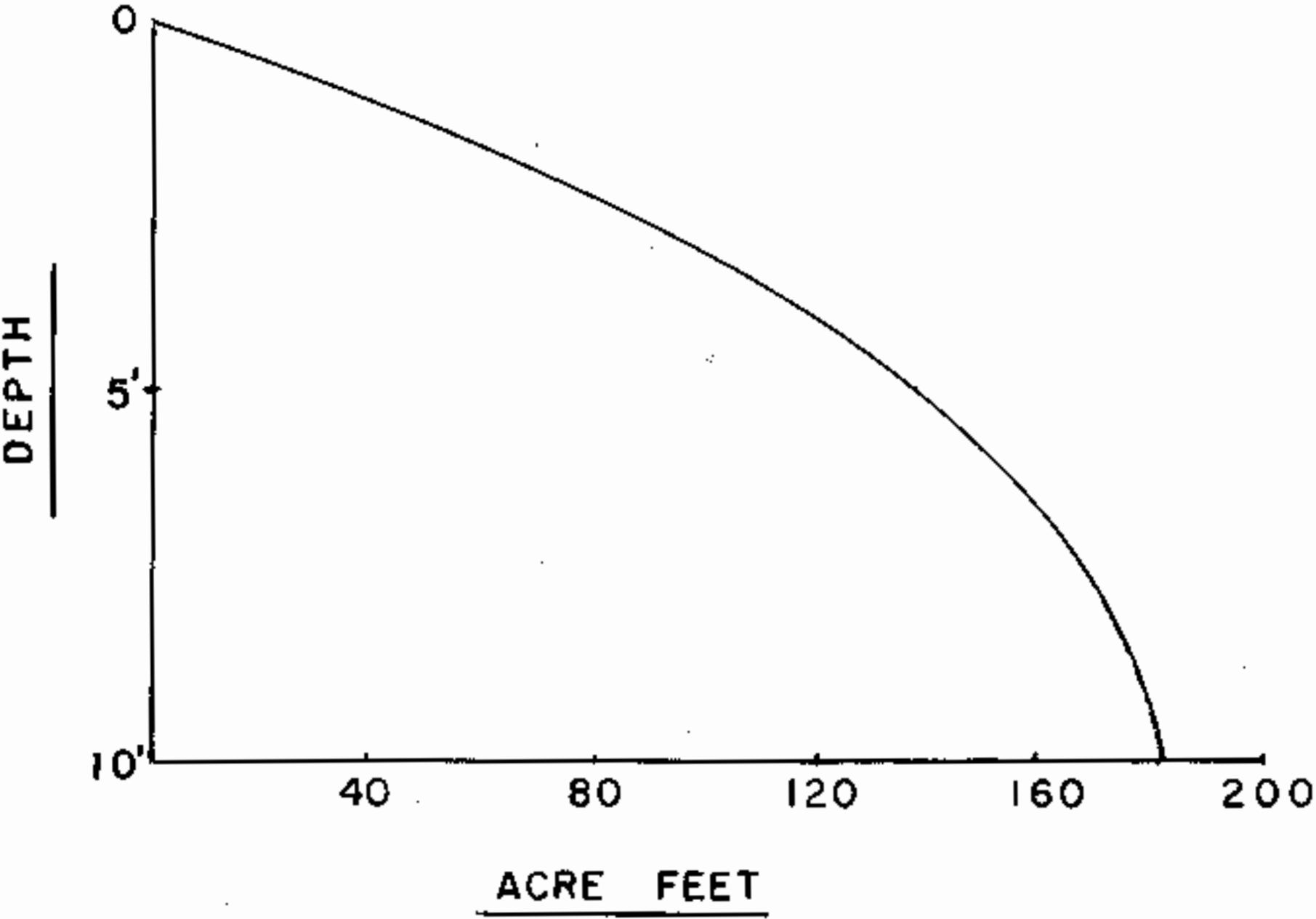

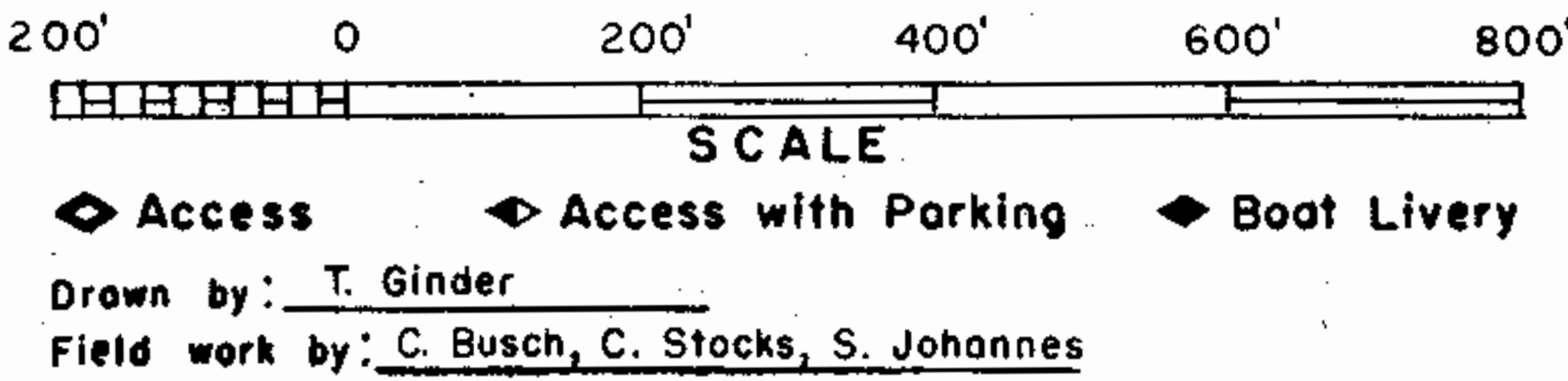


B.M. 'X' is a 2" square cut in top of a
