

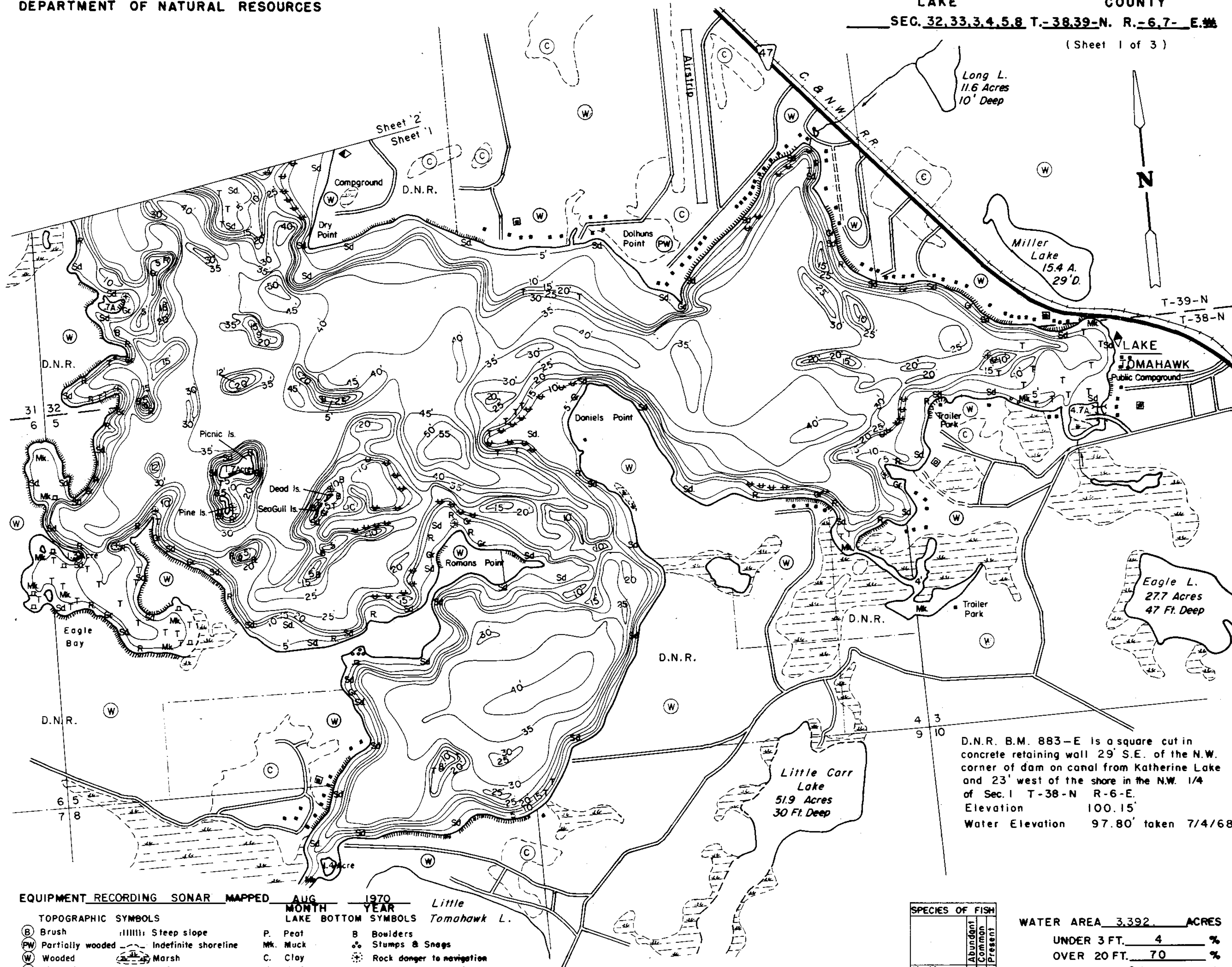
LAKE SURVEY MAP

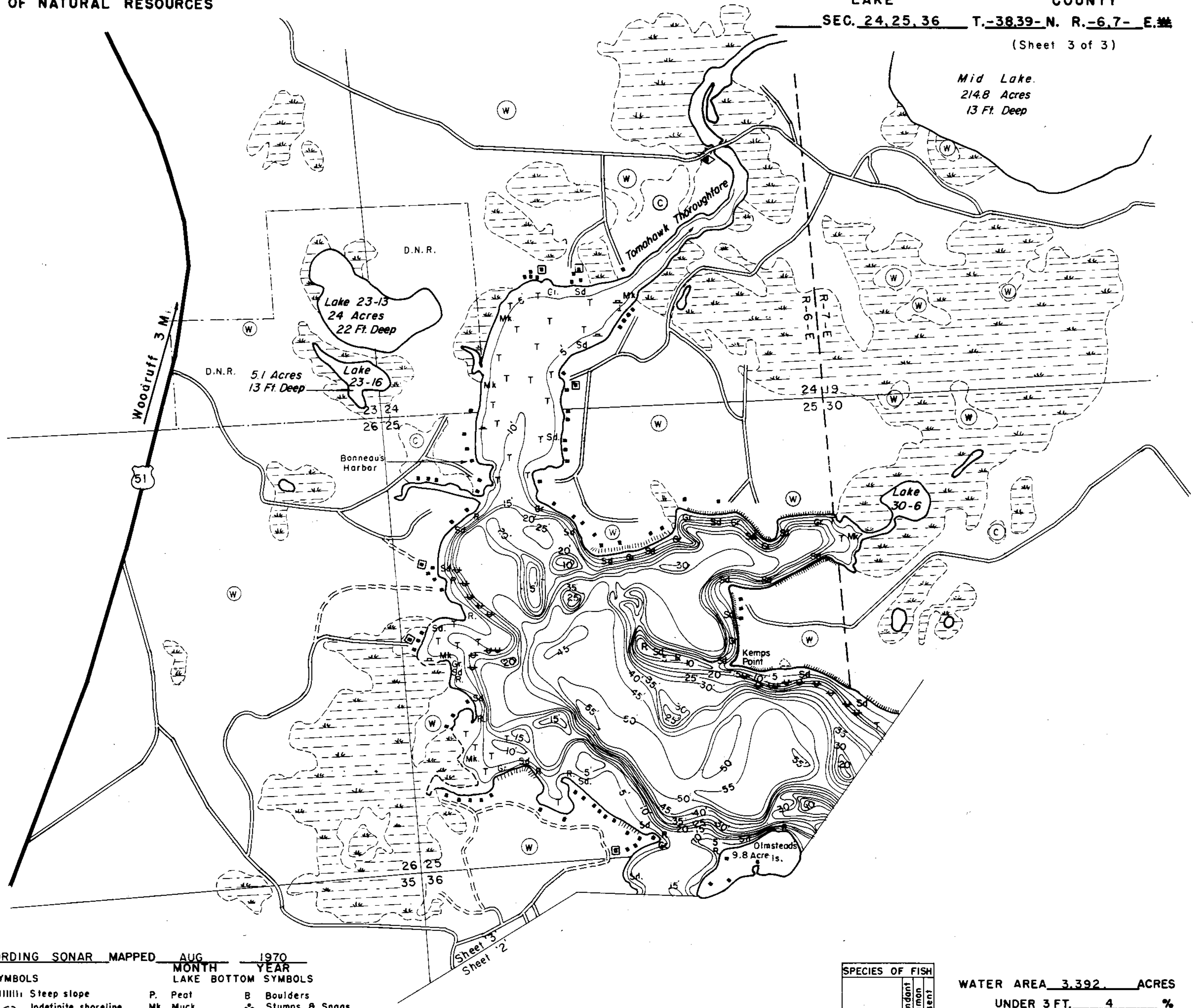
