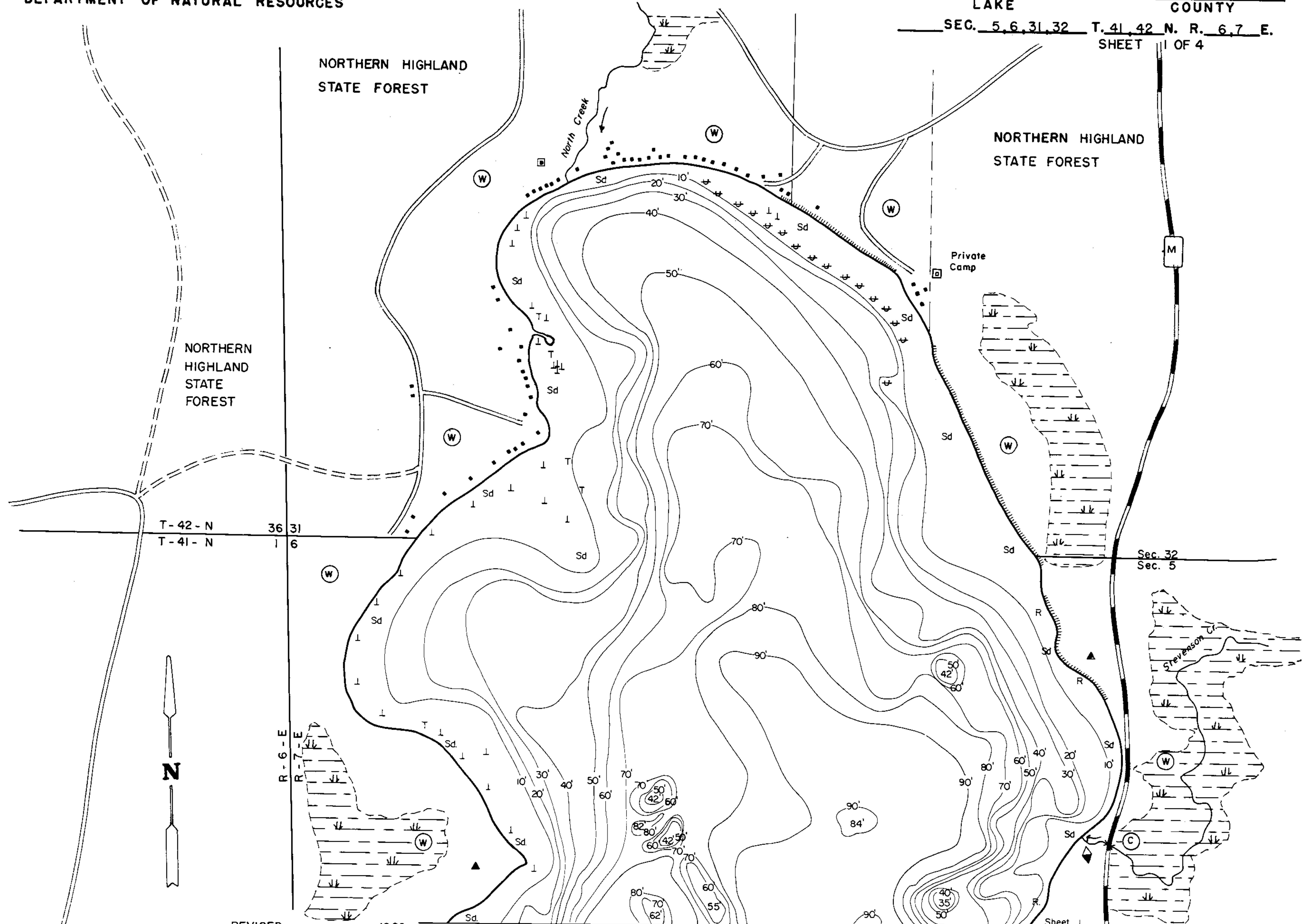


LAKE SURVEY MAP

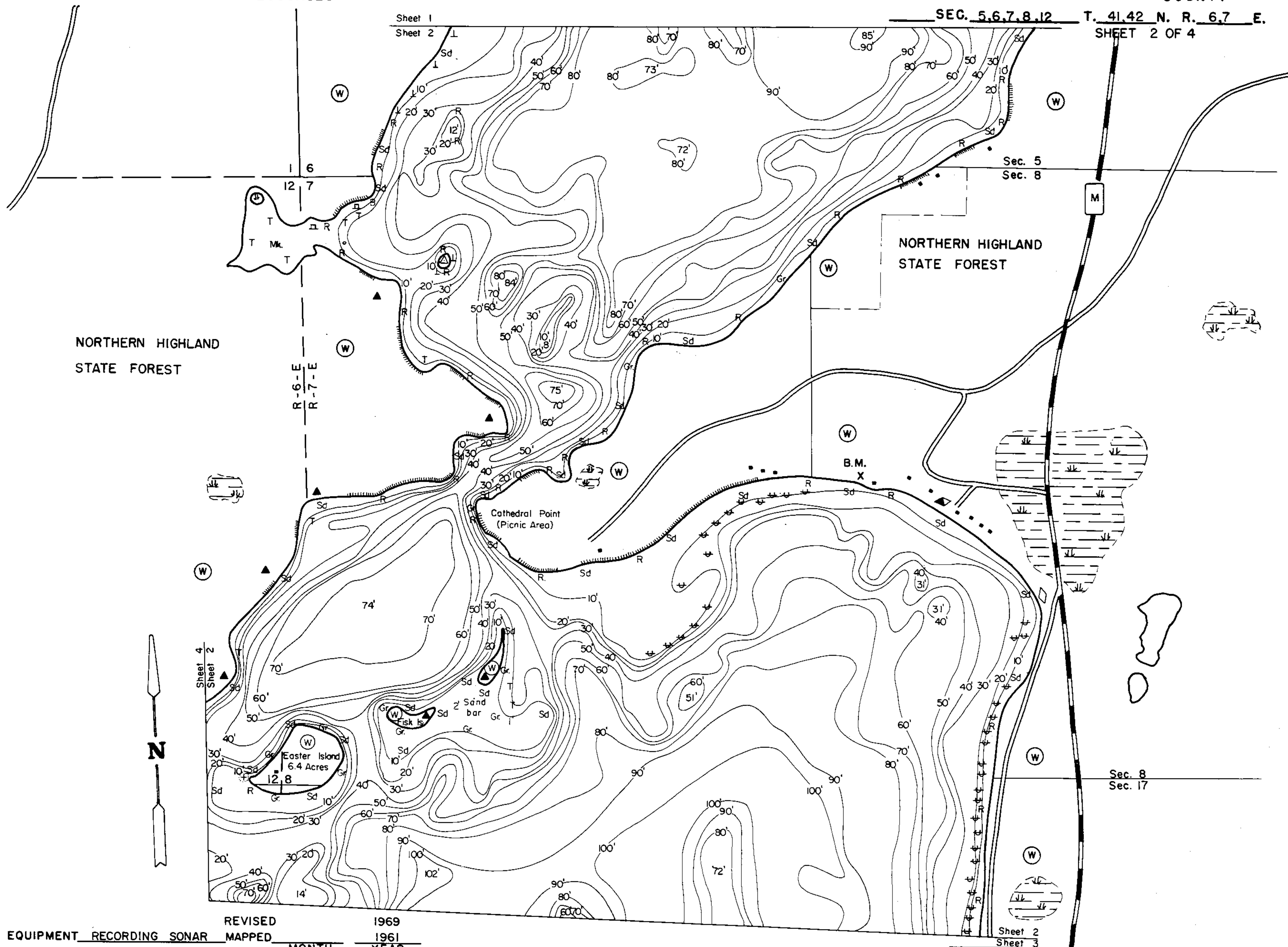

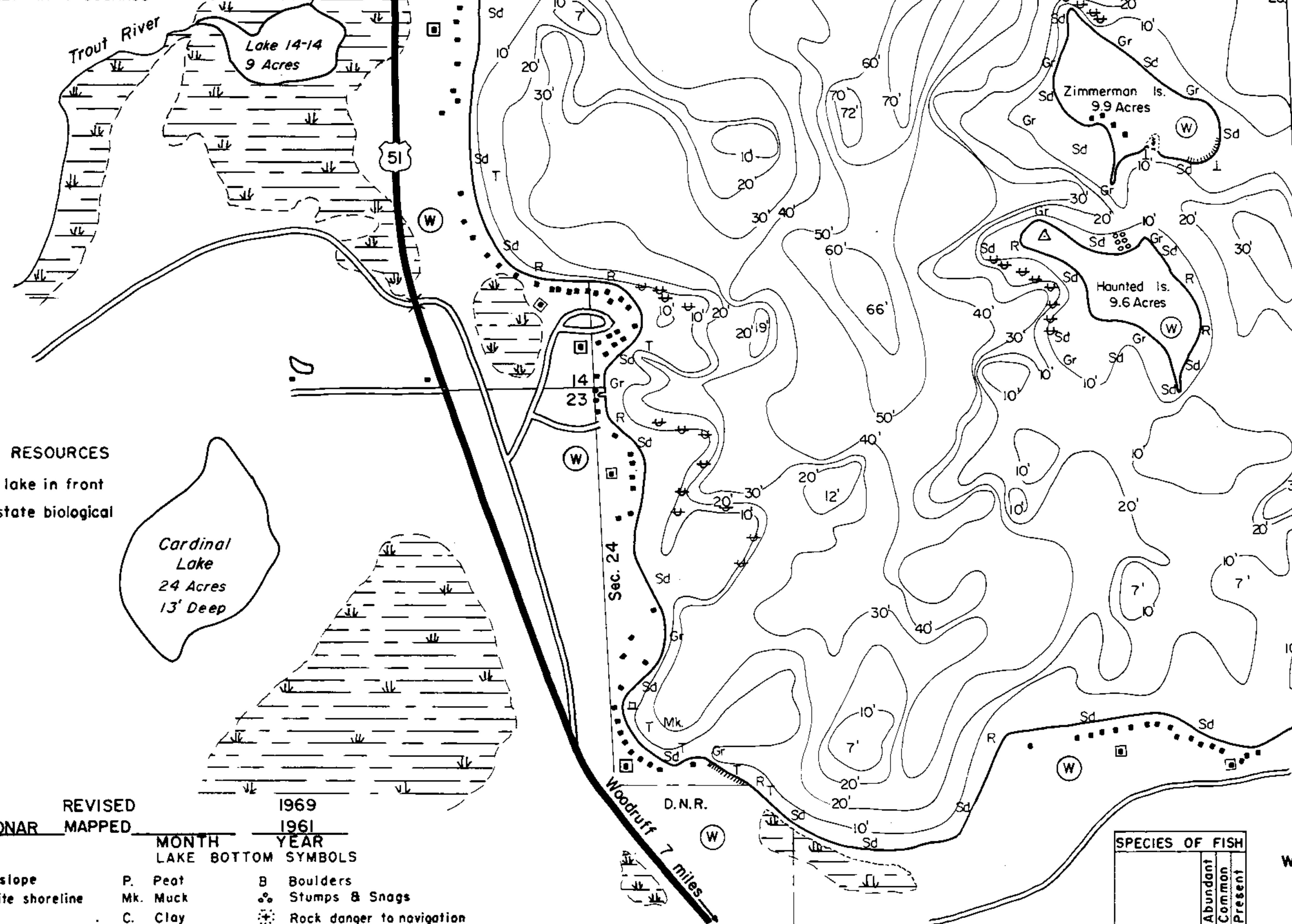
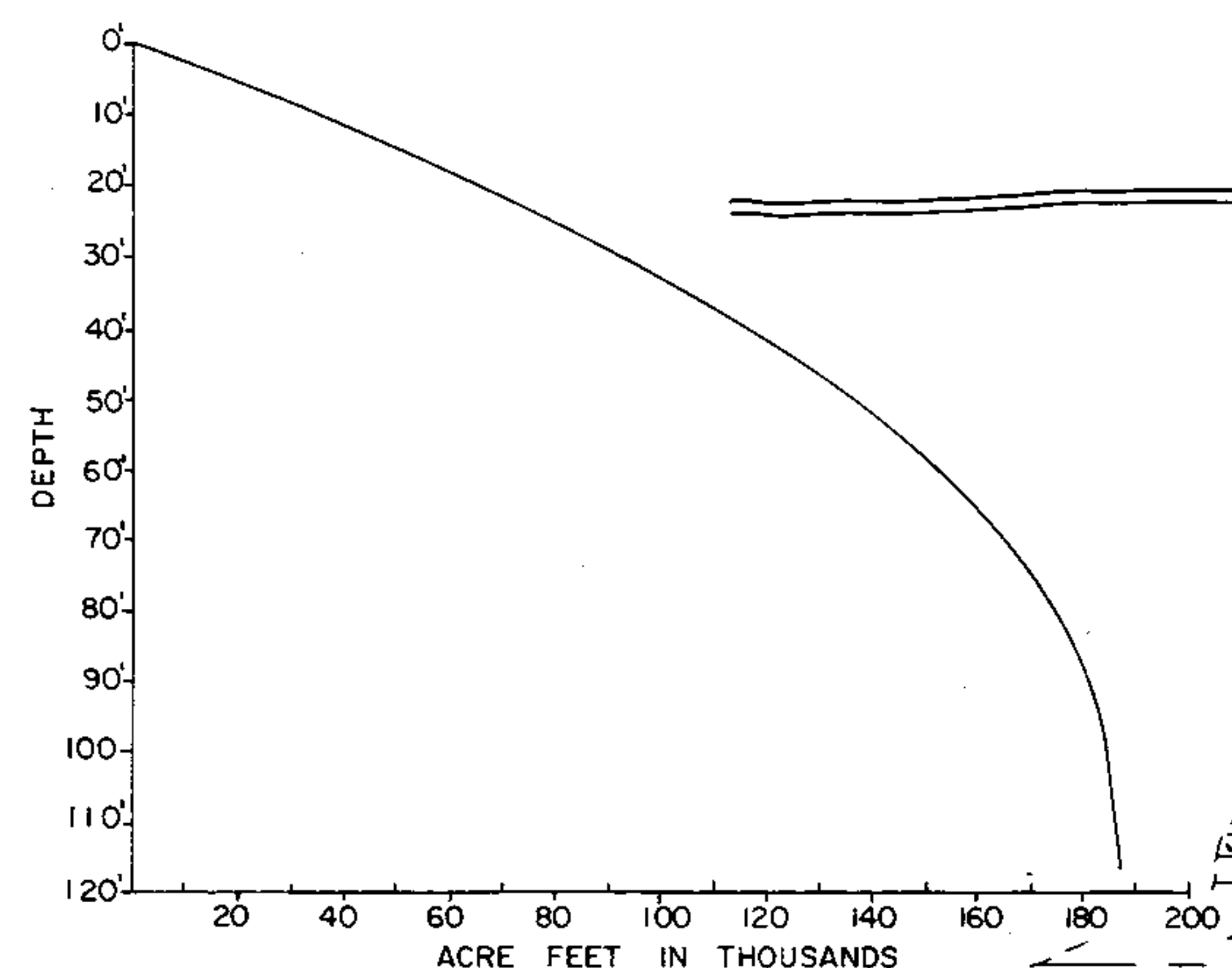
