Franklin Nature Trail

Distance & Time: 1.1 miles, loop, allow up to 45 minutes *Trail Surface:* Packed-dirt, erosion steps, footbridges

Rocks & Roots: Occasional

Difficulty: Easy Terrain: Hilly

Elevation Gain: 72 feet Assurance Markers: Yes

Extended Nature Trail

Distance & Time: 0.5 miles, loop, allow up to 20 minutes

Trail Surface: Packed-dirt, erosion steps

Elevation Gain: 70 feet Assurance Markers: Yes

Conservancy Trail

Distance & Time: 2.0 miles, loop, allow up to one hour This trail ends on the Extended Nature Trail, 0.75 mile
