Amnicon Falls State Park trails and day use areas are open year-round from 6:00 am to 11:00 pm for non-campers

A Wisconsin State Park Vehicle Admission Sticker is required. Daily or Annual

Pets are allowed on the waterfall trails but must be kept under control on a leash no longer than 8 feet. Pets are not allowed in the picnic areas or on nature trails

### Location

**Main Entrance:** 46.608457, -91.887296



### Recreation & Attractions

Amnicon River, Upper Falls, Lower Falls, Snake Pit Falls, Now & Then Falls, sandstone canyon, Horton Bridge, hiking, Thimbleberry Nature Trail, sandstone quarry, scenic pine forest, picnicking, camping (*tent & RV/trailer*), snowshoeing

### Amenities

#### **Park Office**

Staffed office, information, restrooms (*running water, accessible flush toilets*), firewood (*fee \$*)

#### **Waterfall Areas**

Parking, reservable shelter, drinking water, accessible vault toilets, accessible overlook, picnic grounds (*shade, tables, grills, firepit*), children's playground

#### **Campground**

35 campsites (*non-electric*), drinking water (*water fountains with spigots*), accessible vault toilets, children's playground

### Waterfall Trails

**Distance & Time:** 1.0 mile; allow up to 2 hours

**Trail Surface:** Varies, crushed stone, packed dirt, erosion steps, boardwalks, footbridges. Accessible overlook for Upper Falls

**Rocks & Roots:** Occasional

**Difficulty:** Very easy

**Terrain:** Mostly flat with easy inclines

**Elevation Gain:** < 50 feet

**Assurance Markers:** Yes

### Thimbleberry Nature Trail

**Distance & Time:** 0.8 mile, loop; allow up to 1 hour

**Trail Surface:** Packed dirt, erosion steps, boardwalks, footbridges












**Rocks & Roots:** Moderate

**Difficulty:** Easy

**Terrain:** Hilly, occasional steep inclines

**Elevation Gain:** 210 feet

**Assurance Markers:** Yes
