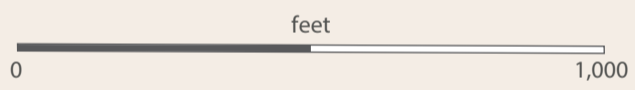

Pattison State Park trails and day use areas are open year-round from 6:00 am to 11:00 pm for non-campers

A Wisconsin State Park Vehicle Admission Sticker is required. *Daily or Annual*

Pets are allowed on the waterfall trails but must be kept under control and on a leash no longer than 8 feet. A designated pet picnic area is next to the campground with lake access. Pets are not allowed in the main picnic areas or on the nature trails.

Recreation & Attractions

Black River, Big Manitou Falls, Little Manitou Falls, Rocky Gorge, scenic river area (*rapids & minor falls*), Interfalls Lake, swimming, lake paddling, picnicking, boreal forest, hiking, tent & RV/trailer camping, backpack camping, Gitche Gumee Nature Center, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing

Amenities

Park Office

Staffed office, information, park maps, restrooms (*running water, accessible flush toilets*), firewood (*\$ fee*)

Big Manitou Falls & Interfalls Lake

Parking, paved pathways (*day use areas*), scenic overlooks, accessible overlooks, nature center, reservable shelter, swimming beach, picnic areas (*shade, tables, grills*), childrens playground, pet picnic area (*shade, tables, grills, lake access*), sand volleyball court, basketball half-court, horseshoe pits, drinking water (*water fountains with spigots, hand pump*), restrooms (*running water, accessible flush toilets*)

Little Manitou Falls

Parking, accessible pathways, accessible scenic overlook, picnic area (*shade, tables, grills*), childrens playground, drinking water, accessible vault toilets

Campground

59 campsites (*18 electric, 41 non-electric*), drinking water (*water fountains with spigots*), shower building (*running water, accessible heated showers, accessible flush toilets*), accessible vault toilets, garbage & recycling, dump station

Backpack Campsites

3 backpack campsites, vault toilets, shelter (*Overlook Trail*)

Big Manitou Falls Overlook Pathways

Distance & Time: 0.5 mile, allow up to 2 hours

Trail Surface: Wide, paved pathways with steps and stairways. Accessible trail segments and overlooks

Rocks & Roots: Minimal

Difficulty: Very easy

Terrain: Mostly flat with easy inclines

Elevation Gain: < 50 feet

Assurance Markers: Yes

Big Manitou Falls River Trail

Distance & Time: 1.0 mile, out-&-back, allow up to 1 hour

Trail Surface: Varies, crushed stone or packed dirt, erosion steps & stairways

Rocks & Roots: Occasional

Difficulty: Moderate

Terrain: Hilly

Elevation Gain: 145 feet (*uphill return*)

Assurance Markers: Yes

Beaver Trail

Distance & Time: 2.0 miles, loop, allow up to 1 hour, 30 minutes

Trail Surface: Varies, crushed stone or packed dirt, erosion steps, boardwalks & footbridges

Rocks & Roots: Occasional

Difficulty: Easy

Terrain: Mostly flat with gentle inclines

Elevation Gain: 50 feet

Assurance Markers: Yes, trail markers & map signs at junctions

Little Manitou Falls Overlook

Distance: < 200 feet

Trail Surface: Crushed stone accessible pathway, footbridge

Rocks & Roots: Minimal

Difficulty: Very easy

Terrain: Flat

Elevation Gain: N/A

Assurance Markers: Yes

Little Manitou Falls Trail

Distance & Time: 0.6 miles, point-2-point, 30 minutes

Trail Surface: Varies, crushed stone or packed dirt, erosion steps

Rocks & Roots: Occasional

Difficulty: Easy

Terrain: Mostly flat with short easy inclines

Elevation Gain: < 50 feet

Assurance Markers: Yes, trail markers & map signs at junctions

Overlook Trail

Distance & Time: 1.2 miles, loop, 40 minutes

Trail Surface: Varies, crushed stone or packed dirt, erosion steps

Rocks & Roots: Occasional

Difficulty: Easy

Terrain: Rolling

Elevation Gain: 85 feet

Assurance Markers: Yes, trail markers & map signs at junctions

Oak Ridge Trail

Distance & Time: 0.8 miles, point-2-point, 30 minutes

Trail Surface: Packed dirt

Rocks & Roots: Occasional

Difficulty: Easy

Terrain: Rolling

Elevation Gain: 60 feet

Assurance Markers: Yes, trail markers & map signs at junctions

River View Trail

Distance & Time: 2.0 miles, point-2-point; allow up to 1 hour, 30 minutes

Trail Surface: Packed dirt

Rocks & Roots: Occasional

Difficulty: Easy

Terrain: Gently rolling

Elevation Gain: 50 feet

Assurance Markers: Yes, trail markers & map signs at junctions
