Moose Lake Campground sits along its namesake lake on the Great Divide Ranger District. This serene lake and surrounding forest offer a spectacular location for families to enjoy nature on the Chequamegon-Nicolet National Forest. This small and semi-secluded campground offers about 15 single-family campsites for tent and RV camping. Each site is equipped with tables and campfire rings with grills. Accessible vault toilets, drinking water, and trash/recycling collection facilities are provided.

Moose Lake is a 1,670-acre body of water that is popular for fishing, boating, and swimming. Elk, eagles, loons and other wildlife are often viewed in and near the campground. This location provides access to a variety of activities, including miles of offroad vehicle, hiking, and


mountain biking trails.

Anglers will find an abundance of musky, walleye, bass and pan fish in the lake, and the clear water is ideal for kayaking, canoeing, and swimming. A sandy beach and a boat ramp provide convenient lake access.



Location:

From Hwy 77, take FR 174 south and drive 1 mile to intersection with FR176. Turn right and continue on FR174 for 5.1 miles. Turn right on campground road (FR1643) and drive 1.5 miles to the campground.

From County Hwy B, turn north onto Barker Lake Road and drive 4.7 miles to the intersection with Fishtrap Road (FR 172). Continue straight for 1.2 miles, then turn left (north) on FR 174. Go 3.5 miles, turn right (northeast) and follow FR 164 for 1.2 miles. Turning left, follow FR174 until you reach campground road (FR 1643) on left. Campground is 5 miles to the campground.
